Learned counsel for the petitioners Mr. A. K. Chaturvedy has submitted that he has filed one interlocutory application being I.A. No. 4674 of 2020 for ignoring the surviving defect no. 9(i) which relates to arrangement of pagination of Annexure-1.

2. So far as defect no. 9(ii) is concerned, the learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the word "both" is missing before the address mentioned in the cause title immediately after the name of the petitioner no. 2, and in fact, petitioner no. 1 and petitioner no. 2 have the same address. The learned counsel submits that this is apparent from the *Vakalatnama* also. He submits that this defect may also be ignored or he may be permitted to add word "Both" in the address portion and office may be directed to do the needful.

3. Learned counsel for the opposite party- State Mr. Saket Kumar has no serious objection to the prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners.

4. After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioners, the defect no. 9(i), as pointed out by the office, is hereby ignored.

5. So far as defect no. 9(ii) is concerned, as submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners the address of both the petitioners are same. The prayer of the petitioner is allowed and the address of both the petitioners is taken as same.

Accordingly, the office is directed to carry out necessary correction by inserting the word "both" in cause title of the bail petitioner by inserting the word "both" immediately before the address mentioned in the cause title.

6. I.A. No. 4674 of 2020 is disposed.
7. Put up this case on 25.09.2020 under appropriate heading.
