

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegations against the petitioners are all false and general and omnibus in nature. It is further submitted that because of marital discord between the parties, this false case has been foisted against the petitioner after a decade of solemnization of marriage with the complainant. Hence, it is submitted that the petitioner be given the privileges of anticipatory bail.

Learned A.P.P appearing for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

List this case on 02.11.2020.

Considering the submissions of learned counsels and the facts as discussed, I am inclined to pass an interim order of anticipatory bail to the petitioner till 02.11.2020. In case of the petitioner being arrested by the police on or before 02.11.2020, he shall be released on bail **provisionally** on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the officer concerned in connection with Jamtara P.C.R. Case No.04 of 2020 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
