The matter was taken up through Video Conferencing. Learned counsels for the parties had no objection with it and submitted that the audio and video qualities are good.

7/ 24.06.2020. Heard learned counsel for the appellant and the learned counsel for the State on the Interlocutory Application filed by the appellant for renewing the prayer for bail during the pendency of this appeal.

The appellant has been convicted for the offences under Sections 363, 366 and 376 (2) (i) of the Indian Penal Code and has been sentenced to undergo R.I for ten years with fine for the offence under Section 376 (2) (i) of the Indian Penal Code.

Earlier the prayer for bail of the appellant was rejected on merits.

Learned counsel for the appellant has renewed the prayer for bail, submitting that the appellant is in custody since the year 2013 itself and has completed more than half of the sentence.

In the facts of this case and taking into consideration the period of custody of the appellant, we are inclined to release the appellant, Mahesh Paswan, on bail. Accordingly, the appellant, named above, is directed to be released on bail, during the pendency of this appeal, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand), with two sureties of the

like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-II, F.T.C., Bermo at Tenughat, in connection with Sessions Case No.313 of 2013.

The Trial Court below, however, before issuing the release order, shall satisfy itself that the appellant has served more than half of the sentence and if this statement is found to be incorrect, the release order shall not be issued by the Trial Court below and the matter shall be reported to this Court.

The aforesaid interlocutory application stands allowed with the direction as above.
