**Order No.02 Dated- 09.09.2021**

Heard the parties through video conferencing.

Apprehending their arrest in connection with Jugsalai P.S. Case No.72 of 2021 instituted under Sections 323, 324, 356, 382, 504, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, the petitioners have moved this Court for grant of privileges of anticipatory bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the allegation against the petitioners is that the petitioners, in a drunken state, in furtherance of the common intention with the co-accused persons beat the informant/ opposite party No.2 on his already injured leg. It is submitted that the allegation against the petitioners is false. It is next submitted that there was dispute between them regarding the encroachment made. It is also submitted that the petitioners undertake that they will not disturb or annoy the informant in any manner during the pendency of the case. It is lastly submitted that the petitioners are ready and willing to co-operate with the investigation of the case and to jointly pay ad interim victim compensation of Rs.20,000/- to the informant without prejudice to their defence in this case. Hence, it is submitted that the petitioners be given the privileges of anticipatory bail.

Learned Addl.P.P appearing for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners.

Considering the submissions of learned counsels and the facts and circumstances stated above, I am inclined to grant privileges of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Accordingly, the petitioners are directed to surrender in the Court of learned J.M., Jamshedpur within six weeks from today and in the event of their arrest or surrendering, they will be enlarged on bail on jointly

depositing a demand draft of Rs.20,000/- as ad interim victim compensation without prejudice to their defence in this case drawn in favour of the informant and on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty five thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned J.M., Jamshedpur in connection with Jugsalai P.S. Case No.72 of 2021 **with the condition that they will co-operate with the investigation of the case and appear before the investigating officer as and when noticed by him and furnish their mobile number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card with an undertaking that they will not change their mobile number during the pendency of the case and they will not disturb or annoy the informant in any manner during the pendency of the case** and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

In case the petitioners deposit the said demand drafts, the court below is directed to issue notice to the informant and on his proper identification, the court below shall handover the same to him forthwith.
