Heard the learned counsel appearing for the respective parties.

The petitioner is an accused in connection with Deoghar (Cyber) P.S. Case No. 82 of 2020.

On a raid conducted by the police, the petitioner was apprehended and from his possession mobiles and SIMs were recovered. He was suspected to be involved in cybercrime.

The petitioner does not have any criminal antecedent as stated in this application and he is in custody since 01.12.2020.

Regard being had to the above, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-II, Deoghar in connection with Deoghar (Cyber) P.S. Case No. 82 of 2020, subject to the condition that one of the bailers should be a close relative of the petitioner.
